HOW TO COLLECT YOUR FREE FOOD HAMPER THIS CHRISTMAS

- 1.) Complete the Online Form via this link: <https://bit.ly/freehamper2023> in order to register your interest. You need to have a valid email address and you would also need to log in to your Google account.
- 2.) Submit proof of Benefit or Asylum Seekers Support. You'll need to upload an official letter dated within the last 6 months, that confirms your Name, Address and benefit received (e.g. JSA, ESA, Universal Credit, Pension Credit, etc) OR upload your Home Office letter as proof of Asylum status.
- 3.) You will receive your Unique Collection Number with a specific collection appointment date and time. This will be sent to the email address that you provided on the form.
- 4.) Bring your Unique Collection Number and valid Photo ID on your allocated collection appointment date and time, to pick up your hamper.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- 1.) Collection is by **appointment only**. You will only be served at your collection appointment date and time. To avoid disappointment, please do not come to collect at any other time.
- 2.) Only **one Hamper per family**. (Defined as people living at the same address).
