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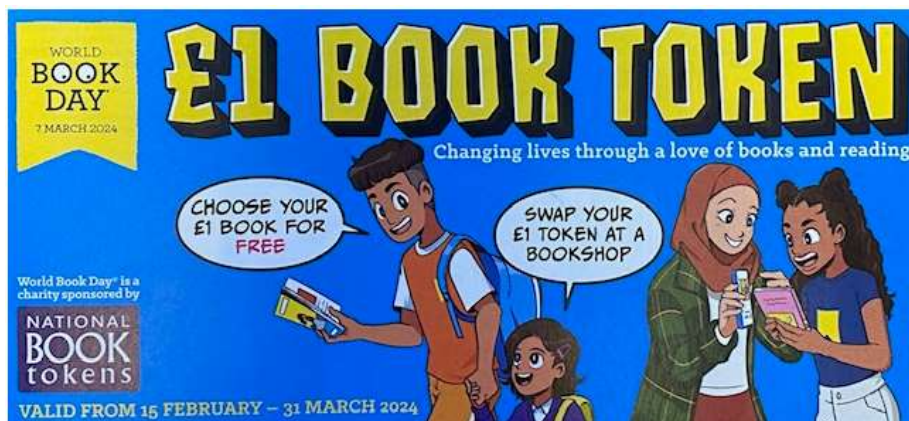
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During the half term break is a great opportunity to visit the library and borrow lots of fabulous books, stories, information books and inspiration for activities!

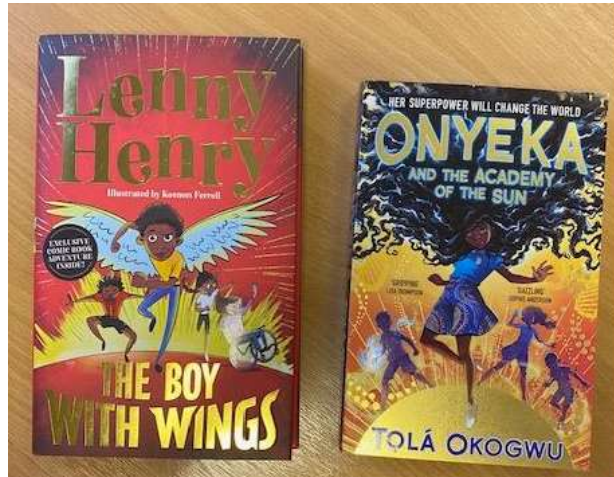
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Many thanks to The Book Trust who have sent us copies of these amazing books for our Year 5 & 6 children. How lucky are they to have their own copies to keep!
